

THE DIG



The Dig includes the following activities:

- 1) **Archaeology:** Students discover the definition of archaeology and how it is used to capture details of time, a country and a person by participating in a class dig. Students learn about the tools of archaeology and the importance of record keeping through a class activity involving description and memory.
- 2) **Art Making:** Students explore the features of ancient coins and make their own.

The Dig can be adapted depending on the age range and prior knowledge of your students to ensure the most is attained from the experience.
